

### **LESSONS**

### 1 Kings 19:3-18

<sup>3</sup>Elijah was afraid, and he ran for his life. He went to Beersheba, which belongs to Judah, and he left his servant there. <sup>4</sup>But he himself went a day's journey into the wilderness. There he sat down under a broom tree, where he prayed that he would die.

He said, "I've had enough, LORD. Take my life, for I am no better than my fathers." <sup>5</sup>Then he lay down and went to sleep under the broom tree.

Suddenly an angel touched him and said, "Get up and eat."

<sup>6</sup>Then he looked around, and near his head there was a loaf of bread baking on coals and a jar of water, so he ate and drank, and then he lay down again.

<sup>7</sup>Then the angel of the LORD came back a second time and touched him and said, "Get up and eat, because the journey is too much for you."

<sup>8</sup>So he got up and ate and drank. Then, with the strength gained from that food, he walked for forty days and forty nights to Horeb, the mountain of God. <sup>9</sup>He came to a cave and spent the night there.

Then the word of the LORD suddenly came to him, saying, "Why are you here, Elijah?"

<sup>10</sup>He said, "I have been very zealous for the LORD, the God of Armies, but the people of Israel have abandoned your covenant. They have torn down your altars and killed your prophets with the sword. I alone am left, and they are seeking to take my life."

<sup>11</sup>Then the LORD said, "Go out and stand on the mountain in the presence of the LORD, for the LORD is passing by." Then a great and powerful wind tore the mountains and shattered rocks before the LORD, but the LORD was not in the wind.

After the wind came an earthquake, but the LORD was not in the earthquake.

<sup>12</sup>After the earthquake there was a fire, but the LORD was not in the fire.

After the fire there was a soft, whispering voice.

<sup>13</sup>When Elijah heard it, he wrapped his face in his cloak, and he went out and stood at the entrance to the cave. Then a voice came to him and said, "Why are you here, Elijah?"

<sup>14</sup>He said, "I have been very zealous for the LORD, the God of Armies, but the people of Israel have abandoned your covenant. They have torn down your altars and killed your prophets with the sword. I alone am left, and they are seeking to take my life."

<sup>15</sup>Then the LORD said to him, "Go back the way you came and go to the Wilderness of Damascus. When you get there, you are to anoint Hazael as king over Aram. <sup>16</sup>You will also anoint Jehu son of Nimshi as king over Israel and Elisha son of Shaphat from Abel Meholah as prophet in your place. <sup>17</sup>Whoever escapes the sword of Hazael, Jehu will kill, and whoever escapes the sword of Jehu, Elisha will kill. <sup>18</sup>But I have preserved in Israel seven thousand whose knees have not bent to Baal and whose lips have not kissed him." (EHV)

#### Hebrews 4:1-11

Therefore, since the promise of entering his rest still stands, let us be fearful that any one of you may be judged to have failed to reach it. <sup>2</sup>In fact, we have had the gospel preached to us, just as they did. But the message they heard did not benefit them, because they were not united in faith with those who did listen. <sup>3</sup>Indeed, we who believe are going to enter his rest.

It happened just as he vowed when he said:

So I swore an oath in my wrath, "They will never enter my rest."

And yet his works have been finished since the creation of the world. <sup>4</sup>For somewhere he has spoken about the seventh day in this way:

And God rested on the seventh day from all his works.

<sup>5</sup>And again in this statement:

They will never enter my rest.

<sup>6</sup>Therefore, since it is still the case that some do enter this rest, and yet those who formerly had the gospel preached to them did not enter because of disobedience, <sup>7</sup>God again set a certain day, namely, "today," when he later said through David, as quoted before:

Today, if you hear his voice, do not harden your hearts.

<sup>8</sup>For, if Joshua had given them rest, then God would not have spoken later about another day.

<sup>9</sup>So there remains a Sabbath rest for the people of God. <sup>10</sup>For the one who enters God's rest also rests from his own work, just as God rested from his work. <sup>11</sup>Therefore, let us make every effort to enter that rest, so that no one will fall into the same pattern of disobedience. (EHV)


