<sup>25</sup>Then King Darius wrote to all the peoples, nations, and languages that dwell in the entire earth:

May your peace and prosperity increase.

<sup>26</sup>I give this command throughout my royal dominion:

People should continually tremble and be afraid before the God of Daniel, because he is the living God, who endures forever.

His kingdom will not be destroyed, and his dominion is eternal.

<sup>27</sup>He rescues and he saves.

He works signs and wonders in heaven and on earth.

So he saved Daniel from the power of the lions.

<sup>28</sup>So this Daniel prospered during the reign of Darius, that is, during the reign of Cyrus the Persian. (EHV)

<sup>32</sup>Now the passage of Scripture the eunuch was reading was this:

so he does not open his mouth.

<sup>33</sup>In his humiliation justice was denied him.

Who will talk about his generation?

## GOSPEL

*Matthew 2:1-12*

*please stand*

**M** The Gospel according to Matthew chapter 2.

After Jesus was born in Bethlehem of Judea, when Herod was king, Wise Men from the east came to Jerusalem. They asked, <sup>2</sup>"Where is he who has been born King of the

Jews? We saw his star when it rose and have come to worship him.”<sup>3</sup>When King Herod heard this, he was alarmed, and all Jerusalem with him.<sup>4</sup>He gathered together all the people’s chief priests and experts in the law. He asked them where the Christ was to be born.<sup>5</sup>They said to him, “In Bethlehem of Judea, because this was written through the prophet:

<sup>6</sup>You, Bethlehem, in the land of Judah, are certainly not least among the rulers of Judah: because out of you will come a ruler, who will shepherd my people, Israel.”

<sup>7</sup>Then Herod secretly summoned the Wise Men and found out from them exactly when the star had appeared.<sup>8</sup>He sent them to Bethlehem and said, “Go and search carefully for the child. When you find him, report to me, so that I may also go and worship him.”

<sup>9</sup>After listening to the king, they went on their way. Then the star they had seen when it rose went ahead of them, until it stood still over the place where the child was.<sup>10</sup>When they saw the star, they rejoiced with overwhelming joy.<sup>11</sup>After they went into the house and saw the child with Mary, his mother, they bowed down and worshipped him. Then they opened their treasures and offered him gifts: gold, frankincense, and myrrh.<sup>12</sup>Since they had been warned in a dream not to return to Herod, they went back to their own country by another route. (EHV)

## SERMON

*2 Kings 5:1-5, 15-17*

Na'aman, the commander of the king of Aram's army, was a great man in the opinion of his master. He was highly honored because the LORD had provided victory for Aram through him. Although he was a powerful warrior, he had leprosy.

<sup>2</sup>Raiding parties had once gone out from Aram and brought back a young girl. She served Na'aman's wife. <sup>3</sup>She said to her mistress, "I wish my master stood before the prophet who is in Samaria, because he would cure him of his leprosy."

<sup>4</sup>So Na'aman went and told his master what the servant girl from the land of Israel had said.

<sup>5</sup>Then the king of Aram said, "Go there. I will send a letter to the king of Israel." So Na'aman went...

<sup>15</sup>Then he and his whole escort went back to the man of God. He stood in front of Elisha and said, "To be sure, now I know that there is no God in all the earth except in Israel. Now accept a gift from your servant."

<sup>16</sup>But Elisha said, "As surely as the LORD lives, in whose presence I stand, I will not take anything." Even though Na'aman urged him to accept something, he refused.

<sup>17</sup>Then Na'aman said, "If you do not want anything, please give me, your servant, as much dirt as two donkeys can carry, for your servant will never again burn incense or sacrifice to other gods, but only to the LORD.


