

CONFESSION AND ABSOLUTION

- M This is the day the Lord has made.
- C Let us rejoice and be glad in it.

- M Christ Jesus was delivered over to death for our sins.
- C He was raised to life for our justification.
- M Oh, come, let us sing unto the Lord.
- C Let us make a joyful noise to the Rock of our salvation.
- M Oh, come, let us worship and bow down.
- C Let us kneel before the Lord, our Maker.
- M On Golgotha the cross stands empty. Morning breaks upon the empty tomb. As we come before our God and King, let us confess our sins.
- Lord God, I humbly come before you. I confess that I am sinful in thought, word, and deed. I daily fail to do what you command, and continually do what you forbid. Lord, I am sorry for my sins. I believe that for the sake of my lord Jesus Christ, you will have mercy on me.
- M Upon this your confession, by Christ's command and authority, I forgive you all your sins in the name of Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. The vacant cross and the empty tomb are God's signs to you that he has accepted the sacrifice of his one and only Son in your place. Whoever believes in Him has eternal life. The Lord is my strength and my song.

SECOND LESSON 1 Corinthians 15:19-26

¹⁹If our hope in Christ applies only to this life, we are the most pitiful people of all.
²⁰But in fact Christ has been raised from the dead, the firstfruits of those who have fallen asleep. ²¹For since death came by a man, the resurrection of the dead also is going to come by a man. ²²For as in Adam they all die, so also in Christ they all will be made alive. ²³But each in his own order: Christ as the firstfruits and then Christ's people, at his coming. ²⁴Then comes the end, when he hands over the kingdom to God the Father, after he has done away with every other ruler and every other authority and power. ²⁵For he must reign "until he has put all his enemies under his feet." ²⁶Death is the last enemy to be done away with. M The Gospel according to Mark chapter 16.



When the Sabbath was past, Mary Magdalene, Mary the mother of James, and Salome bought spices so they could go and anoint Jesus. ²Very early on the first day of the week, at sunrise, they went to the tomb. ³They were saying to each other, "Who will roll the stone away from the entrance to the tomb for us?" ⁴When they looked up, they saw that the stone, which was very large, had been rolled away.

⁵As they entered the tomb, they saw a young man dressed in a white robe sitting on the right side, and they were alarmed. ⁶He said to them, "Do not be alarmed. You are looking for Jesus the Nazarene, who was crucified. He has risen! He is not here. See the place where they laid him. ⁷But go, tell his disciples and Peter, 'He is going ahead of you into Galilee. There you will see him, just as he told you.'"

⁸They went out and hurried away from the tomb, trembling and perplexed. They said nothing to anyone, because they were afraid. (EHV)
